

# Crossing Guard



The Washington Township Police Department is conducting a hiring process for the position of Crossing Guard.

No person shall be appointed as an adult school crossing guard unless he / she is:

- 18 years of age;
- Is a citizen and resident of this State;
- Is sound in body and of good health;
- Is of good moral character; and
- Has not been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude.

Rate: \$18.00 per hour

Crossing Guard posts typically consist of 30 minutes in the morning and 30 minutes in the afternoon on school days.

All interested applicants should visit the department's website and go to the "**Careers at WTPD**" section. Applicants must ensure that all eligibility requirements are met and then download and print the "**Application**" and "**Physicians Report**".

All candidates must submit the application, a copy of their valid New Jersey Driver's License, and physicians report by October 1, 2020 at 5pm.

***Incomplete application packets will not be accepted.***
