

# Recognizing **JOSEPH WODARCZYK, JR**

**WHEREAS** Washington Township takes great pride in the accomplishments of its youth in all activities and in recognizing young people who have aspired to excellence in the classroom, through the community or in the field of scouting and

**WHEREAS** Joseph Wodarczyk, Jr. joined Cub Scout Pack 220 in September 2006 as a Tiger Cub at Whitman School. He received the Arrow of Light in March 2011, the highest honor in Cub Scouts; and

**WHEREAS** Joseph Wodarczyk, Jr. was a Den Chief for Cub Scout Pack 220 for 3 years until 2014. He received the Den Chief Award in 2014. Aside from Den Chief, his other leadership roles in Troop 81 included Troop Historian, Assistant Patrol Leader and Patrol Leader. Joseph was elected to “The Order of the Arrow”, which is the Honor Society of Scouting and completed his Ordeal in April 2014; and

The Park renamed the area “Eagle Scout Way”, where a pole now stands with scouts' names who have completed their eagle projects.
