

Recognizing **NICHOLAS EDWARD CONBOY**

WHEREAS: Washington Township takes great pride in the accomplishments of its youth in all activities and in recognizing young people who have aspired to excellence in the classroom, through the community or in the field of scouting; and

WHEREAS: Nicholas Conboy started scouting as a Tiger in Pack 220 out of Whitman Elementary School in September of 2006. He obtained his Arrow of Light and crossed over to Boy Scout Troop 81 in March of 2011. Since joining Troop 81, Nicholas advanced quickly through the ranks of Scouting; and

WHEREAS: Through the years Nicholas has earned a total of 29 merit badges, has 87 nights of camping, hiked 15 miles and has over 179 service hours. In January of 2013, Nicholas was elected by his peers to the Order of the Arrow and completed his Ordeal in June of 2013. He has earned the Ajepeu Award, Totin' Chip, Polar Bear Club, God & Church and hiked the trails at Gettysburg; and

WHEREAS: Nicholas' Eagle Project was entitled "Commemorating the Veterans of Bethel Cemetery". Nicholas lead volunteers to help construct and install a sign board and reflection bench to be placed near an existing brick veteran's memorial located at the back corner of Bethel Cemetery. The sign board included a map of the cemetery and on the opposite side, a posting of descriptions of various wars. The "posting" included dates, places and a brief description of the different wars. He also directed volunteers to replace the shrubbery with two new shrubs, re-mulched where necessary and cleaned up the existing monument.
