

Recognizing **ZACHARY ARMSTRONG**

WHEREAS: Washington Township takes great pride in the accomplishments of its youth in all activities and in recognizing young people who have aspired to excellence in the classroom, through the community or in the field of scouting; and

WHEREAS: Zachary Armstrong started his scouting career as a Webelo in Pack 81. In 2010, Zachary earned his Arrow of Light and crossed over to Boy Scout Troop 81. Since joining Troop 81, Zachary advanced quickly through the ranks of Scouting; and

WHEREAS: On his trail to Eagle, Zachary has camped over 100 nights, hiked 37 miles and contributed 195 hours of community service. He has earned 29 merit badges, with an additional 4 this past summer camp. Zachary attended the 2013 National Scout Jamboree in West Virginia; and

WHEREAS: Zachary was elected to Scouting's Camping Honor Society, the Order of the Arrow in February of 2012, completing his Ordeal in June of 2012. He has earned these special awards: Totin' Chip & The Gettysburg Heritage Trail twice. Zachary's leadership positions include Quartermaster and Jr. Assistance Scoutmaster; and

WHEREAS: Zachary's Eagle project was completed on behalf of Alley Cat Animal Rescue and consisted of building 3 shelters and 3 feeding stations for homeless cats. The shelters and feeding stations were placed at various homeless cat colonies in the Philadelphia area.
