

ORDINANCE 09 - 2019

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
GLOUCESTER COUNTY**

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 260-28A OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON ENTITLED “EMERGENCY VEHICLE
ACCESS ONLY”**

WHEREAS, Chapter 260 of the Code of the Township of Washington provides for the regulation of traffic in the Township of Washington; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a new section in Chapter 260 which regulates portions of the Township roadway network for emergency vehicle access only; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Governing Body is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Township by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 260, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic” shall be amended to add the following Section: “Section 260-A, Emergency Vehicle Access Only”

SECTION 2: Section 260-28A, Emergency Vehicle Access Only shall include the following location:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Location</u>
Spring Lake Avenue	Starting at a point 95 feet north of the Northerly curb line of Spring Lake Court to a Point 160 feet north of the northerly curb Line of Spring Lake Court.

SECTION 3: Regulatory signs, conforming to the current *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways*, current edition, shall be erected and maintained at the above-designated location.

SECTION 4: Except as set forth in Sections 1-3 above, the balance of Chapter 260 of the Code of the Township of Washington shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 6: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage by Council or twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor, whichever comes first.
