

ORDINANCE 2 – 2016

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
GLOUCESTER COUNTY**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON
TO CREATE AN ADVISORY PARADE COMMITTEE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey as follows:

- A. Creation; composition; terms of office. There is hereby created an Advisory Parade Committee which shall consist of nine members who shall serve without compensation for the term of one year from the first day of January of the year of appointment. The Committee shall be comprised of the following members, all of whom must be residents of the Township:
 - 1. Two members of Township Council appointed by vote of the Council.
 - 2. Seven citizen members appointed by vote of Township Council.

- B. Responsibilities. The Committee shall advise the appropriate Township Officials regarding Township sponsored parades and conduct fundraising efforts in order to provide for a parade or parades to be conducted in Washington Township. Any funds raised by the Committee shall be deposited in a dedicated Trust Account, controlled by the Township Chief Financial Officer, to be used solely for parade related expenses. Should the parade for which funds are collected not occur, all funds collected or pledged shall be returned.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage by Council or twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor, whichever comes first.
