**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 260 SECTIONS 25 AND 27 OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON IN ORDER TO DESIGNATE STOP
INTERSECTIONS AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS IN THE RESIDENTIAL
DEVELOPMENT COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS TALL OAKS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington that pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39-140, Chapter 260 Section 25 of the Township Code is hereby amended to provide the following additional Stop intersections.

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Stop Signs on:</u>
Willow Oak Court & White Oak Court and Scarlet Oak Road	Willow Oak Court
Westerly English Oak Drive and Scarlet Oak Road	English Oak Drive
English Oak Drive and Pin Oak Court Easterly Intersection of English Oak Drive and Scarlet Oak Road	Pin Oak Court English Oak Drive

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39-140, Chapter 260 Section 27 of the Township Code is hereby amended to provide the following additional Yield intersections:

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Yield Signs on:</u>
English Oak Drive and Spanish Oak Court	Spanish Oak Court
English Oak Drive and Red Oak Court	Red Oak Court
English Oak Drive and Black Oak Court	Black Oak Court

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that pavement markings and warning signs, conforming to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, shall be erected and maintained at the above-designated location.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage by Council or twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor, whichever comes first.
