

ORDINANCE 19 - 2018

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
GLOUCESTER COUNTY

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19, ARTICLE I OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
WASHINGTON ENTITLED "DOGS AND CATS"

WHEREAS, Chapter 19, Article I of the Code of the Township of Washington regulates Dogs and Cats in the Township of Washington; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to amend and update Chapter 19 Article I;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, that the Code of Washington Township is hereby amended, revised, and/or supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 19, Article I, Section 19-2 C of the Code of the Township of Washington, entitled "Application of license" shall be deleted and is hereby replaced with the following:

"19-2C Application for license; when made. Applications for licenses for dogs which are required to be licensed by the provisions of § 19-2A(1) shall be made before January 31 of each calendar year. In all other cases, the application for a license shall be made within 10 days of the day upon which the dog in question first becomes subject to the provisions of this Chapter."

SECTION 2: Chapter 19, Article I, Section 19-8 A of the Code of the Township of Washington, entitled "Violations" shall be deleted and is hereby replaced with the following:

"19-8 A. Violations. For any violation of the Licensing Provisions under this Chapter: same may be filed by the Office of Township Clerk or the Office of Code Enforcement. All other complaints may be filed by either citizens or police for the violation of any of the other regulations of on either public or private property."

SECTION 3: Except as set forth in Sections 1 above, the balance of Chapter 19, and the balance of the Code of the Township of Washington, shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

SECTION 5: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage by Council or twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor, whichever comes first.


