**RESOLUTION AWARDING A BID FOR 124 APPALOOSA WAY EMERGENCY EROSION REPAIR
TO RAHN CONTRACTING, LLC, PROJECT #08-18-T-399**

WHEREAS, advertisement for bids for the 124 Appaloosa Way Emergency Erosion Repair Project was duly published in the South Jersey Times; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on Tuesday, April 6, 2020 at 10:00 A.M.; and

WHEREAS, there were five (5) bids submitted as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid proposal of **Rahn Contracting, LLC**, 534 N. Black Horse Pike, Blackwood, NJ 08012 in the amount of \$129,929.25 is the lowest responsible bidder for 124 Appaloosa Way Emergency Erosion Repair, Project #08-18-T-399; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer of the Township of Washington in a letter dated April 9, 2021 recommends the award of the contract contingent upon approval by the Township Solicitor and funds being available; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township of Washington the following:

1. Rahn Contracting, LLC, 534 N. Black Horse Pike, Blackwood, NJ 08012 is determined to be the lowest responsible bidder for 124 Appaloosa Way Emergency Erosion Repair.
2. The Mayor of the Township of Washington is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Rahn Contracting, LLC in a form approved by the Solicitor of the Township of Washington.
3. The Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available to be drawn from budget line item C04-55-829-000-902, 2016 Bond for Erosion Concerns.
4. Notice of the contract award shall be published in the South Jersey Times.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Washington, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq, the contract is awarded to **Rahn Contracting, LLC**.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of the resolution be forwarded to the CFO, Administrator, Qualified Purchasing Agent, Professional and Vendor for their records.
