**RESOLUTION AWARDING A BID FOR 2020 ROAD PROGRAM – PHASE II
TO LEXA CONCRETE, LLC, PROJECT #08-18-T-398**

WHEREAS, advertisement for bids for the 2020 Road Program – Phase II Project was duly published in the South Jersey Times; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on Wednesday, June 30, 2021 at 10:00 A.M.; and

WHEREAS, there were six (6) bids submitted as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid proposal from **Lexa Concrete, LLC**, 11 Commerce Way Drive, Hammonton, NJ 08037 in the amount of \$650,328.05 is the lowest responsible bidder for the 2020 Road Program – Phase II, Project #08-18-T-398; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer of the Township of Washington in a letter dated July 2, 2021 recommends the award of the contract contingent upon approval by the Township Solicitor and funds being available; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township of Washington the following:

1. Lexa Concrete, LLC, 11 Commerce Way Drive, Hammonton, NJ 08037 is determined to be the lowest responsible bidder for 2020 Road Program – Phase II.
2. The Mayor of the Township of Washington is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Lexa Concrete, LLC in a form approved by the Solicitor of the Township of Washington.
3. The Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available to be drawn from budget line item C04-55-837-000-901 entitled 2020 Road Program.
4. Notice of the contract award shall be published in the South Jersey Times.


