**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE WITHDRAWAL OF RAHN CONTRACTING, LLC AND
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO CAPELA CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR 124 APPALOOSA WAY
EMERGENCY EROSION REPAIR, PROJECT #08-18-T-403**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution R109-2021, Rahn Contracting, LLC was the lowest responsible bidder and awarded the contract for 124 Appaloosa Way Emergency Erosion Repair Project #08-18-T-403; and

WHEREAS, in a letter dated July 22, 2021, the Township Engineer, Remington & Vernick, has reported that Rahn Contracting, LLC has advised that they intend to withdraw from the project; and

WHEREAS, Capela Construction is now the lowest responsible bidder with a base bid amount of \$133,950.00; and

WHEREAS, Capela Construction, Inc., 20 Tranquility Court, Southampton, NJ 08088 has stated in a letter dated July 19, 2021, that they are willing to accept the award of bid for the sum of \$133,950.00 for the project.

WHEREAS, the Engineer of the Township of Washington recommends the award of the contract contingent upon approval by the Township Solicitor and funds being available; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township of Washington the following:


1. Capela Construction, Inc., 20 Tranquility Court, Southampton, NJ 08088 is determined to be the lowest responsible bidder for the 124 Appaloosa Way Emergency Erosion Repair Project.
2. The Mayor of the Township of Washington is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Capela Construction, Inc. in a form approved by the Solicitor of the Township of Washington.
3. The Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available to be drawn from budget line item C04-55-829-000-902, 2016 Bond for Erosion Concerns.
4. Notice of the contract award shall be published in the South Jersey Times.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Washington, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq, the contract is awarded to Capela Construction, Inc.




