Dear Senior Center Member:

I hope this letter finds you well and that you are enjoying this beautiful autumn weather. We are thrilled to welcome you back to the Washington Township Senior Center as it reopens on a full-time basis beginning Monday, October 25, 2021. The hours of operation will be from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Please be advised, the Senior Center follows all State Covid-19 guidelines. All persons entering the Senior Center are required to wear a mask, regardless of your vaccination status. If you do not have a mask, we will provide you with one. You may remove your mask when seated. A mask must be worn when walking to restrooms and/or anytime you leave your seat. All persons must sign in each day you visit the Senior Center. There will be a daily sign in sheet located at the front counter. In addition, upon your first visit to the Senior Center, all persons must sign a Waiver of Liability Agreement. We will continue with all safety precautions to sanitize the premises.

**Transportation**

- Washington Township bus stops at the Senior Center on Monday, Thursday and Friday. The bus also accommodates those interested in attending the Thursday Senior Hot Lunch Program at the Senior Center. For pick up on any of these days, senior members should call the Parks and Recreation Office at (856) 589-3227 between 8:00 a.m. and 8:15 a.m.

### Lunch Schedule ("Subject to change")

- You are welcome to bring your lunch any day you visit the Senior Center.
- Monday – A light lunch is ordered for a nominal fee (examples: pizza, hoagies, small sandwiches, etc.)
- Tuesday – No lunch order; you are encouraged to bring lunch.
- Wednesday – No lunch order; you are encouraged to bring lunch.
- Thursday – Hot Lunch Program – A hot meal is served for a nominal fee of \$3.00. The menu changes weekly and is sponsored by the local businesses of Washington Township.
- Friday - A light lunch is ordered for a nominal fee (examples: pizza, hoagies, small sandwiches, etc.)

### Daily Activities ("Subject to change")

- Monday - Bingo, Pool, Bridge (other card games); light lunch at minimal fee
- Tuesday –Aerobics, Pool, Duplicate Bridge (other card games); no lunch
- Wednesday –Aerobics, Pool, Bridge (other card games); no lunch
- Thursday – Line Dance, Bingo, Pool, Card games); HOT lunch at minimal fee
- Friday – Bingo, Pool, Bridge (other card games); light lunch at minimal fee

### Monthly Activities (Cost is \$15 per craft activity and requires reservation)

- Once a month (on Tuesdays), AR Workshop of Turnersville will come to the Senior Center to make a craft (reservation needed).
- Once a month (on Wednesdays) The Craft Room will come to the Senior Center to make a craft (reservation needed).

The pandemic has been hard on all of us, but our senior members have had a particularly rough time. The Senior Center re-opening full-time marks a real turning point in being able to get our lives back on track. Thank you for your support, patience, and understanding.
